ANAMED Library Talks continue on October 1 with Lieve Donnellan and Laura Pisanu. The talk is entitled "Archaeological Networks and Social Interaction". The book project Archaeological Networks and Social Interaction aims to improve our understanding of applications of network analysis for studying social interactions in the past. Very successful applications of network analysis exist for studying settlement archaeology and movement through the landscape, but social interactions come with their own complexities. This talk will highlight some of the discussions involved and delve deeper into a detailed case study, that of Pithkoussai, known by most as the first Greek colony in the West. Lieve Donnellan, graduated from Ghent University (BE) in 2012. After postdoctoral positions at the University of Chicago (USA), Göttingen (DE) and Amsterdam (NL), she held a position as Assistant Professor of Classical Archaeology at the University of Aarhus (DK) before moving to a lectureship at the University of Melbourne (AUS) in 2020. She specializes in the Ancient Greek colonization, Greek urban architecture and applications of network analysis in archaeology. She currently conducts fieldwork in Italy and Greece.

Laura Pisanu, is an Archaeologist and a PhD Candidate at the University of Melbourne working on Nuragic sites in western Sardinia and interactions between Sardinia and Mediterranean cultures over the Bronze and Early Iron Age. Laura completed the Scuola di Specializzazione in Beni Archeologici (level 8 EQL), master's and bachelor's degree in archaeology at the University of Cagliari. She has extensive fieldwork experience including at the UNESCO site of Su Nuraxi in Barumini (Sardinia).
